Proposal to Amend the Cardinal Virginians Bylaws

Article VIII, paragraph 2, of the Bylaws states that any member of the chapter may propose an amendment to the bylaws. Bylaws may be amended by a 65% affirmative vote of the members present and voting at a duly-called meeting, providing that prior notice of at least 30 days

has been given of the intent to amend. Approved amendments become effective immediately upon their adoption.

In accordance with the above, I am hereby proposing a modification to Article IV

(Officers), paragraph 2 (Terms of Office) which presently states that: "The President of the chapter shall serve a one year term of office with an extension of one additional year, if so elected, for a maximum of two years".

I propose that it be changed to read "The President of the chapter shall serve a two-year term of office with one additional year, if so elected, and an additional extension of one year, if so elected, for a maximum of four years".
